As I write this Hungary is in a state of crisis. Although the present government was democratically elected two years ago, it has used its two-thirds majority to assail democratic values. It has confiscated private pension funds, passed a media law that is unprecedented in the European Union, taken over independent institutions, restricted the power and independence of the courts, and encroached on the independence of the central bank.

Hungary is also suffering from growing strains of anti-Semitism, attacks on minorities, and extreme nationalism.

The Hungarian Free Market Foundation is launching an educational project in order to spread the ideas of economic freedom, individual liberty, and societal freedom. I invite you to join us in saving Hungary from the forces of the toxic combination of big government, nationalism, and authoritarianism.

I'm an educator by profession. So I started by reminding Hungarians of the ideas that create freedom and prosperity: private property and individual rights, free markets, and constitutionally limited government. I joined with others and we started by publishing the first Hungarian translation of Frederic Bastiat's classic book *The Law*, on the nature of limited government and freedom. We set up a website – www.kapitalizmus.hu -- and are reaching thousands and thousands of Hungarians daily.

For the future of our nation – as free, independent, and prosperous – we want to take our message to the youth of Hungary. We are planning to visit every single secondary school in the country and make presentations to students and provide free books and DVDs and other materials and aids to the schools so that they can understand what freedom is...and what it is not. It is already a generation since the iron grip of the Communists was removed from our country and people are already forgetting what it was to live without freedom. We must remind them.

This educational program will require a strong and organized campaign from our foundation in order to be successful. We are grateful for the generous support from our friends abroad – the Free to Choose Network, which produced Milton Friedman's wonderful television shows, the Atlas Economic Research Foundation, and the UK-based Network for a Free Society, but will need your help, too.
